- You will need: empathy and a bit of knowledge about WWII
- Suitable for Class 2 and 3 - Years 4 - 6

Edinburgh Zoo - webcams or animals

- You will need: an interest in animals
- Suitable for: All ages

NASA - Kennedy Space Centre

- You will need: an interest in all things space
- Suitable for: All ages
