Snap shots of our learning!



Foundation – Foundation have been practicing using their phonics knowledge to spell CVC words using games and craft activities and have been looking at the concept of fewer and more in maths, using sentence stems to help them describe what they found out in their explorations.

Class One – Class 1 have been testing materials to investigate which would make the best umbrella (getting happily wet in the process!) and have been using a compass to locate human features in our school grounds. They have also been busy using number bonds to add 1-digit numbers and to jump to the next ten on a number line.

Class Two – Class 2 have been learning how to use manipulatives to help them with column subtraction using exchanges and have been investigating magnetism in Science. In English they have been writing character descriptions based on the text 'The Worst Witch'.

Class Three – This week, Class 3 have been learning about representing equivalent fractions using fractions walls and have been writing poems about the 2nd World War in English. In RE they have been investigating different Christmas traditions.
