We are collecting plastic bottle lids as a school. We would like to encourage all parents and guardians to start collecting your plastic lids and drop them off into the dedicated collection bin at reception. The bin will be in position until Friday 27th March, so you have plenty of time to collect and donate your plastic.

We are collecting these on behalf of North Notts BID for their community art project, the 'North Notts Mural Trail', which we are very proud to have entered. The school has submitted two designs to be considered by the judging panel, both with an environmental and eco conscious theme.

Those chosen as finalists will then recreate their design into a 2x3ft portrait mural made out of colourful plastic lids. The trail will consist of 30 murals scattered across Bassetlaw for the public to locate.

Medicines

The administration of prescribed medicines is more frequent in the winter months and here is a quick reminder of what we are able to support with:

- All prescribed medicines must be in their original packaging with clear dosage instructions – we will only administer once per day around lunch time unless your child is in Base club
- No medicine can be accepted in school unless a signed consent form is completed at the office
- Pain relief may be administered once in the day if this is consented to by completing the form in the office
- School cannot administer medicines of any kind that have not been brought in by parents and will keep any medicines for the shortest possible time.

Snap shots of our learning!

Foundation – Children have been practicing subitising using a dice (learning to look at a number of objects and recognise them as e.g. 2, without counting), and have been practicing phase 2 tricky words

Class One – Class 1 have been studying the character of Big Bad Pig in their new story and have been using adjectives to describe him in 'Wanted' posters. They have also been working hard on their Christmas performance of 'Lights, Camel, Action!' which is a fresh take on the Nativity story!
