Snap shots of our learning!

Foundation – Foundation children have been learning about penguins in the Antarctic and have painted some beautiful pictures. They have also been talking about overcoming challenges in PSHE and using apparatus in PE to move around like an animal of their choosing!

Class One – in English, Class One have been looking at rhyming verse in ‘George’s Marvellous Medicine’ and comparing it to classical poetry. They made their own medicines today and made sure the corks were tightly on the bottles once they were brewed! In art they have created a weaving loom in a box and are using textured fabrics to create their own material.

Class Two – Class 2 have been investigating factors and factor pairs in maths and have used counters to help them to visualise this. In art, the children have been creating 3-D masterpieces using tints and shades of the same colours and have been learning how to dance Bollywood style in PE.

Class Three – This week, Class 3 have been comparing and simplifying fractions and have been answering in-depth reading comprehension questions linked to their class text ‘Holes’. In PE they have been learning how to create dances using Jive movements.
