## Building works update!

As you will have seen, the builders contracted by Notts CC are still on site at the old building and are busy completing jobs including ensuring the roof is water-tight, replacing the internal joists, repairing water damage including replacing ceilings in the corridor, replastering the water-damaged areas and fitting a new boiler. The flooring in the toilet area has been replaced and the plumbing has been inspected with repairs made where necessary. Some areas have already been redecorated and the rest will be finished when other works are complete.

There are still surveys to be carried out on the floors, so there may need to be further work if repairs are identified. This week, we have been given rough indications that the building may be vacated by the end of this half term, but this will be subject to what the surveys show. As we cannot guarantee the availability of the hall, we will unfortunately be postponing the Mother’s Day lunch on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March until summer, when we will hold a picnic to celebrate the special women in the children’s lives. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause but we will still mark the event by hosting a ‘Mother’s Day gift shop’ where children can purchase surprises for the special day – more news to follow with details of the new date so that there is chance to book time in your calendar ASAP.

## Snap shots of our learning!

**Foundation** – Foundation children have been making bird feeders for the Big Bird Watch that we took part in on Friday and have been thinking about what they want to be when they grow up! They have had lots of fun finding out about vets and practicing looking after animals!

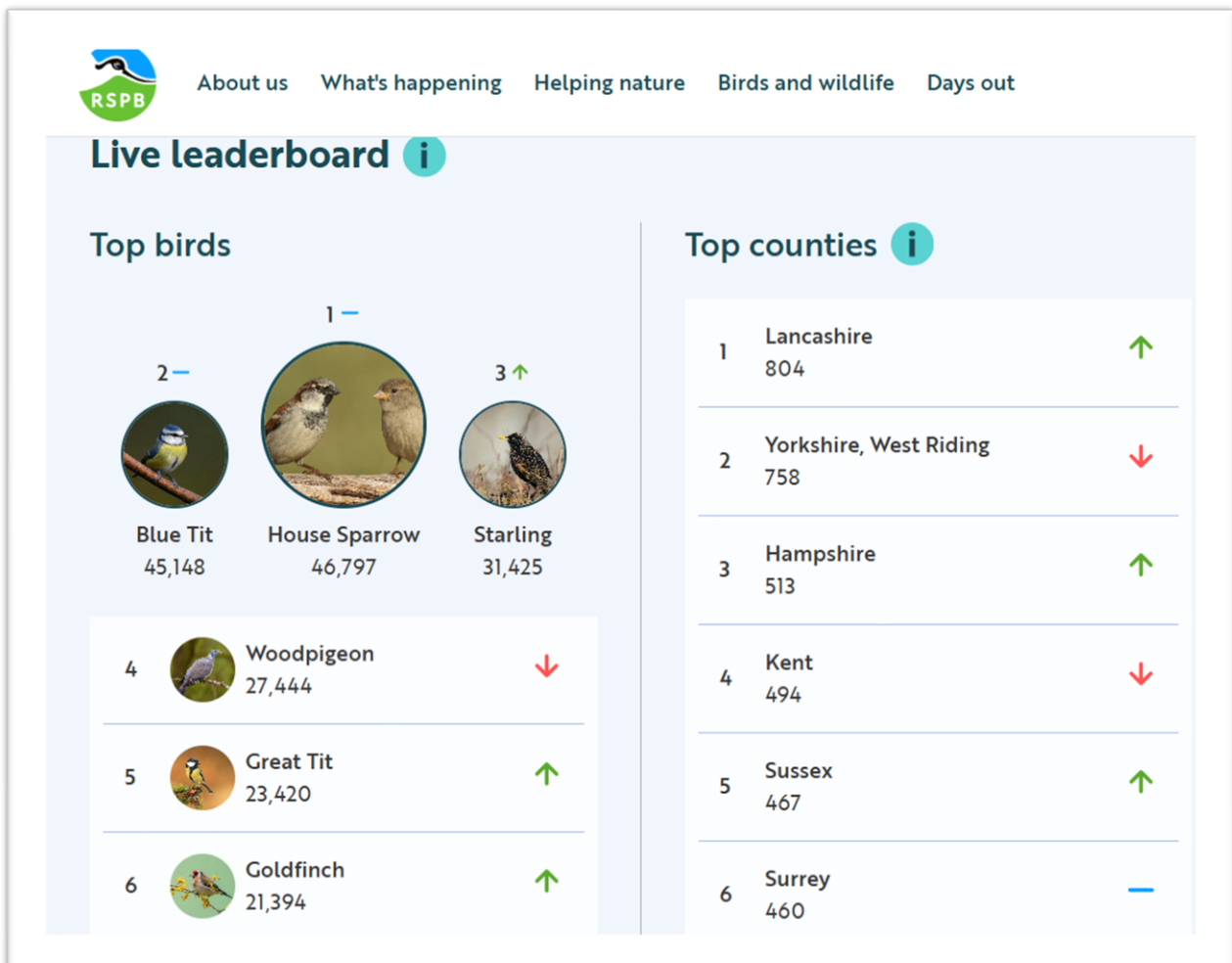
