Phonics Screening and Multiplication Tables Checks



You may be aware that we are required by the DfE to test each child in Year 1 on their understanding of Phonics and children in Y4 on their speed of Multiplication Tables recall. These are standardized checks that occur across the country and will be used to inform next steps in teaching for the children, and give us indications of any changes we need to make in the way we are teaching these skills. At no point are the scores used for any other reason, and in school they will be implemented in a very low-key way as a quiz, very much like the ones we use as a regular part of classroom practice. They are included in the diary dates for you to be aware of, but nothing further is needed as we prepare for these in school. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask class teachers.
