Snap shots of our learning!

Foundation – The book ‘Jasper’s Beanstalk’ has been the inspiration for the children to plant beans and grow them alongside the sunflowers that are already flourishing in the classroom. The plants will be observed as they grow so that children can use their scientific skills to make comparisons!

Class One – Class 1 have been creating their puppets after practicing their joining skills and have been evaluating the methods they have used in their work.

Class Two – Class 2 have been composing music and performing it for the class, using IT to help them bring their compositions to life! They have been considering the features of mountains across the world and comparing the various peaks.
