World Book Day/Onesie-upon-a-time (Dress as a fictional character or wear PJs! Bring a blanket and a teddy for a story!



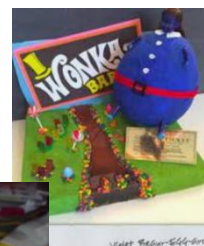

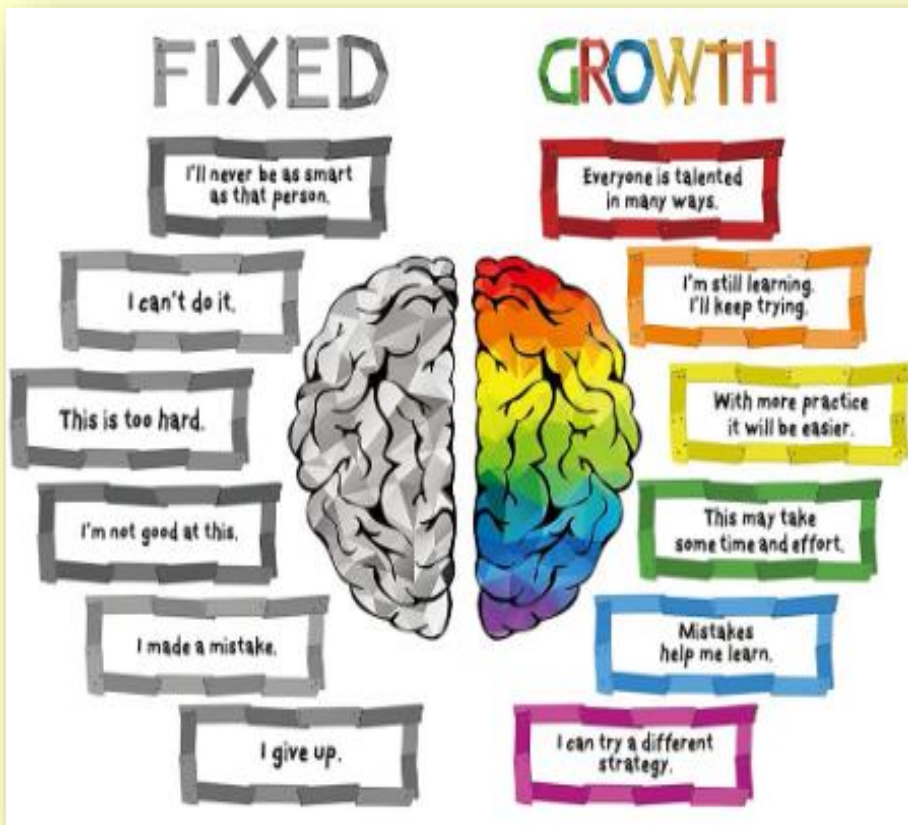

Foundation – Foundation children have been writing about Jack and the Beanstalk and using our art skills to create beautiful still-life paintings of Spring daffodils.

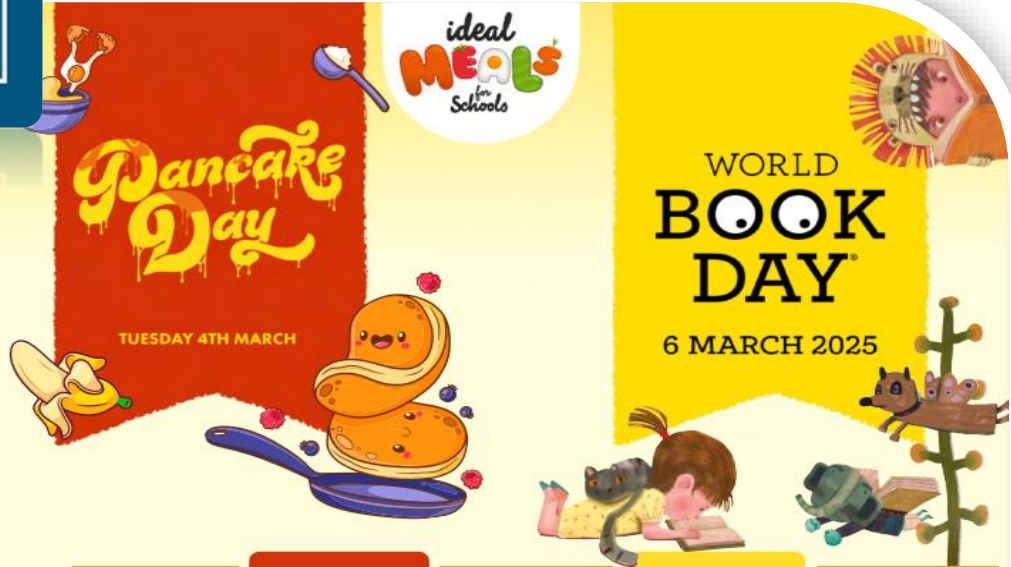
Class One – Class 1 have completed their interviews with Ben the astronaut and have been learning how to partition numbers to ten into component parts.
