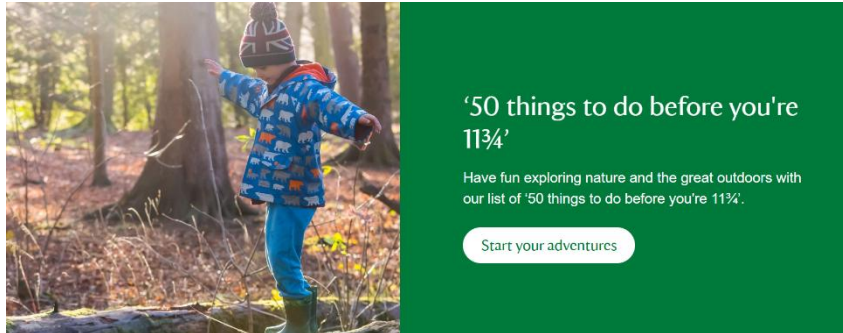
We will be learning how to develop this really life-changing skill over the next few weeks – watch this space!
