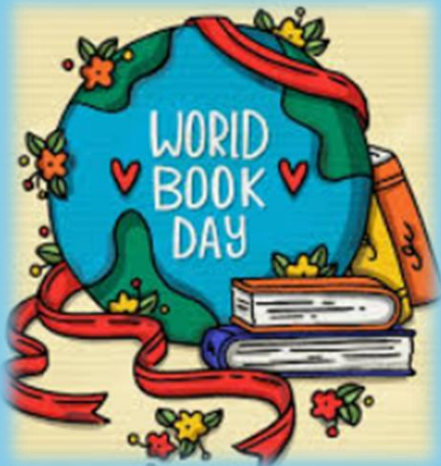

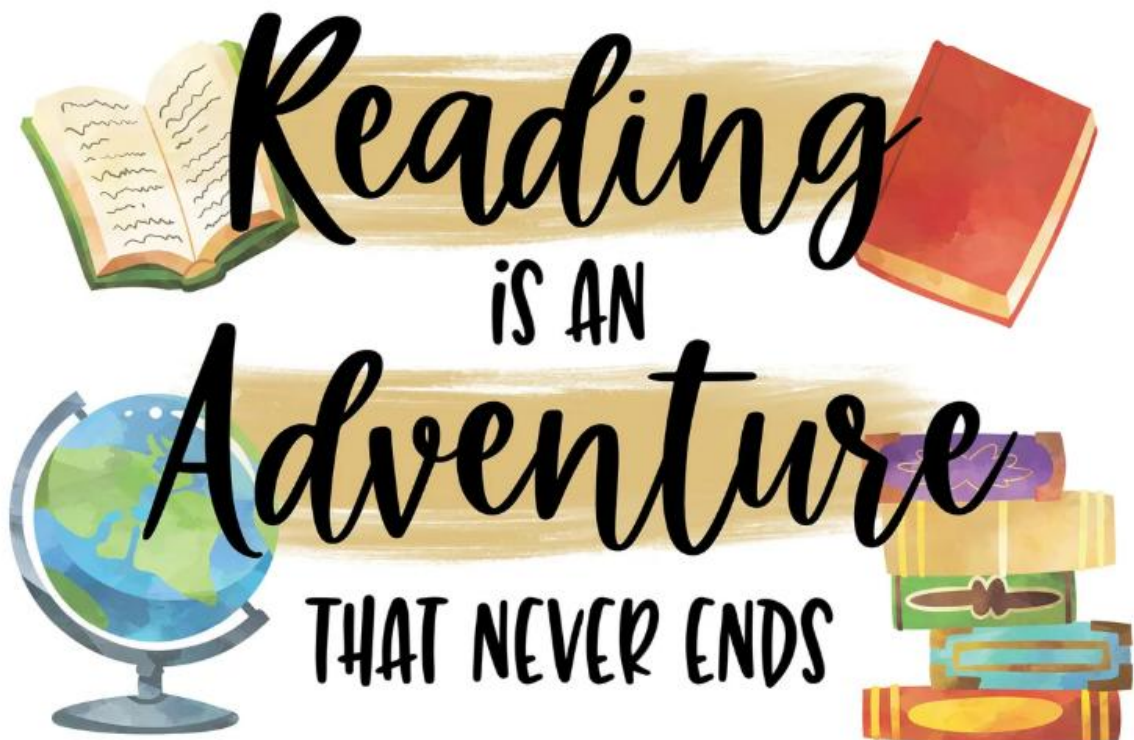
Snap shots of our learning!

Foundation - In PE, the children have been working on developing hockey skills and have had great fun. In maths they have been using objects to help them with adding two numbers together and they have also started to read 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and are excited to grow their own beans.

Class One – The children have written some fabulous fact files about a 'bog baby' using information from the book 'The Bog Baby'. They have been practicing different types of stitches in DT and in music have been interpreting different styles of music from 'The Carnival of the Animals'.

Class Two – In Class two they have started their 'Electrical Personalities' topic and the children investigated household appliances and practiced making a simple circuit. They learned the story map for 'The Time-slip Scarab' and will be writing their own portal story using this as it is linked to their History topic of 'Egyptians' in which they used sources to discuss ancient civilisations and why they might have been built around rivers.

Class Three – This week, Class 3 have been mastering decimals and how to use place value charts as a Maths mastery tool. They have undertaken a design brief in DT to produce a front cover for the LEA RE syllabus front cover using their understanding of a wide range of religions and beliefs and took an exciting journey into 'The Eye of the Storm' in English, where they wrote atmospheric character descriptions of a mysterious, masked pilot of an airship.
