Easter competition news!

We are launching our Easter Egg decorating competition which will be judged on Wednesday 25th March. The theme for 2026 will be 'Fictional Characters' and we would like children to make their entry reflective of a favourite book or story that they know. We will award one winner per class, and the judges will be from the governing body!

We are also running an art competition in conjunction with the parish council and community to create an Easter poster. The winner will be announced at the grand opening of the new play equipment on The Spinney, on Saturday 4th April and the prize will be Easter themed (and will definitely include something chocolatey!). Our school council worked with the community team to help design the area and this will be the first chance to play on it! Snap shots of our learning!

Foundation - To celebrate the Hindu festival of Holi, the children have been using their favourite colours to paint vibrant hearts and continued their artistic explorations and observation skills to create detailed paintings of daffodils. They have also been exploring different shapes and using their mathematical vocabulary to describe 2D shapes.

Class One – Children have extended their work on the book *The Bog Baby* to make their own bog babies and habitats to go with them! In Science they have been exploring different types of weather and finding out why we have the seasons across the year in Beckingham.

Class Two – In Class Two, children have furthered their 'Electrical Personalities' topic and investigated whether materials are conductors or insulators. They have been using their D and T skills and historical understanding to design Egyptian collars so that they can create them next week as part of a textiles project.

Class Three – This week, Class 3 have been using manipulatives such as dienes and counters to represent decimals and comparing this with their understanding of fractions such as tenths and halves. They have researched inspirational leaders as part of RE and have begun to compare the different features of arch and bench bridges, so that they can design their own bridge in the coming weeks that is strong enough to bear a load.

We had an amazing time on World Book Day and the children loved the brand-new all-weather reading shed, kitted out with cushions and crates for their favourite books. We are so grateful for this kind donation to our school by Rotakids and the Muslim Charity, who selected us to be part of their pilot collaborative outdoor reading scheme.

Please could you help us to fill this fabulous addition to our breaktime provision with pre-loved books? We have bought picnic rugs (and previously the picnic benches) from money raised by PTFA fundraisers, that are waiting to be used in the beautiful spring weather, so if you have any books that your family has outgrown, please consider finding them a home with us at BPS. Donations can be dropped in plastic bags in the wooden container next to the reading shed – many thanks for anything you can spare!

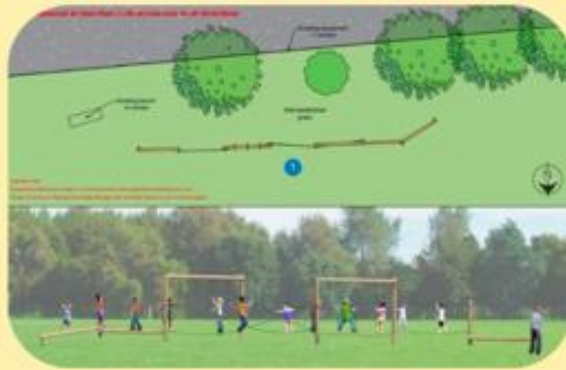
