## Snap shots of our learning!

**Foundation** – The children in Foundation enjoyed a lovely afternoon with their grown-ups at Stay and Play, practicing their maths and phonics skills. They have also thoroughly enjoyed making Easter cards using different crafting techniques.

**Class One** – Children have completed their pencil pots using ‘flange’ joints and they looked amazingly colourful! They have been considering the events of Good Friday, leading up to Easter Sunday and asked some insightful questions when Bishop Paul came to visit as part of our current RE units on Christianity.

**Class Two** – In Class Two, children used their IT skills to begin to understand how to debug an electronic data base and have been tackling problems using fractions in Maths. Their portal stories in English have been edited and final touches put to them before ‘publishing’.

**Class Three** – This week, Class 3 have used the active and passive voice to enable them to write a ship’s log for an exciting adventure into ‘The Eye of the Storm’ and have been investigating the use of trade in building the mighty Sikh Empire as part of their history topic. In maths they have been calculating perimeters and areas of shapes.

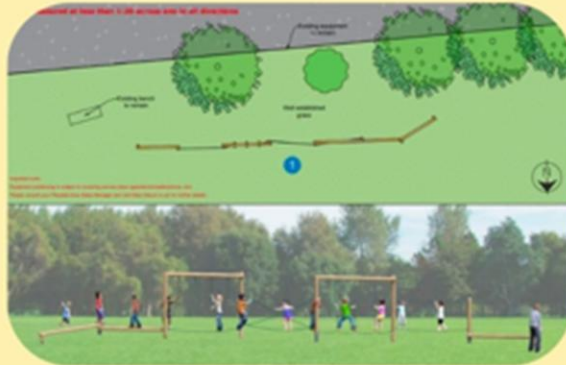
