## Snap shots of our learning!

**Foundation** – Children have been investigating what they would take on a journey into space inspired by the recent Artemis 2 visit to the moon. They have used various ways to measure the length of bean stalks and have been brushing up on their throwing and catching skills in PE.

**Class One** – Class 1 have been using chocolate and sweets to make sense of fractions (they even saved one half of a KitKat for Mrs Furniss!). They have also investigated weight and mass of different items, made wind socks in Science to see which way the wind was blowing and have created an adventurous language bank to create a setting using their senses.

**Class Two** – Class 2 have started reading The Iron Man are making predications using their understanding of the book. They have made 3D sculptures out of cardboard without sticking anything together and have investigated volume and capacity in Maths.

**Class Three** – The class have been discovering ways to help them protect their mental health as they grow up in PSHE and they are writing a biography using inspirational figures. They have been measuring and drawing angles using a protractor in Maths and have been working hard to practice using what is quite a tricky measuring tool!
