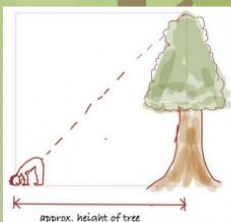

Who can measure the tallest tree?

Have you ever looked up at a tree and wondered how tall it is?

Here is a fun way to find out !

1. Bend over in front of a tree and see if you can see the top.
2. If you can't, move further away until you can.
3. If you can see further than the top of the tree, move closer until you can only see the top.
4. Measure how far away from the tree you are, and that is approximately how tall the tree is!

TT Rockstars Day!!

We are pleased to announce that we will be holding a TT Rockstars Day to promote the learning of Times Tables as a way to really help pupils with fast recall of these important maths facts! Whether it is working out how many cakes to buy for a birthday party, how many roast potatoes each person can have for Sunday lunch or how many eggs they will need for a recipe if they double the amounts, children will need these facts on a regular basis even when they are adults!

Children in Year 1 are required to count in groups of 2, 5 and 10, and this is built on year by year until by the end of Y4, children are able to recall times table facts up to the 12 times table in times of under 6 seconds per fact. There is a statutory test of children's ability to recall the facts at in the summer of Y4 and we use the platform TT Rockstars to help children to learn!!

We are having a day of times-table related fun on Thursday 19th May, and invite pupils to come dressed as a rock star! Please do not feel the need to buy new items for this - be ecologically (and purse!) friendly by jazzing up existing outfits by adding facepaint, back-combed hair and, of course, cool sunglasses!!!

Snap shots of our learning!

Foundation – Children enjoyed sharing their writing skills with parents and grandparents at our ‘Stay and Play’ session this week and it was lovely to see them proudly showing what they have learned. They have discussed how they can care for the world after the Earth Day junk modelling and have learned about recycling and growing vegetables.

Class One – Children have enjoyed exploring measures and capacity in the water tray and have been estimating which containers can hold the most water. As part of history, they have been comparing the flight of the Wright brothers in 1903 with the recent Artemis 2 rocket launch to compare how air travel has changed over the last 120 years.

Class Two – In maths, children have been learning how to convert decimals into fractions and have enjoyed some collaborative work with children in Year 5 designing suggested changes to our school grounds to help us to put a bid together from the Bumble Bee solar farm!

Class Three – Children were visited by representatives from Cero Energy to talk about STEM careers in the renewable energy industry. They have started to learn how scientists classify living things and then burnt off some energy practicing their javelin skills!!
