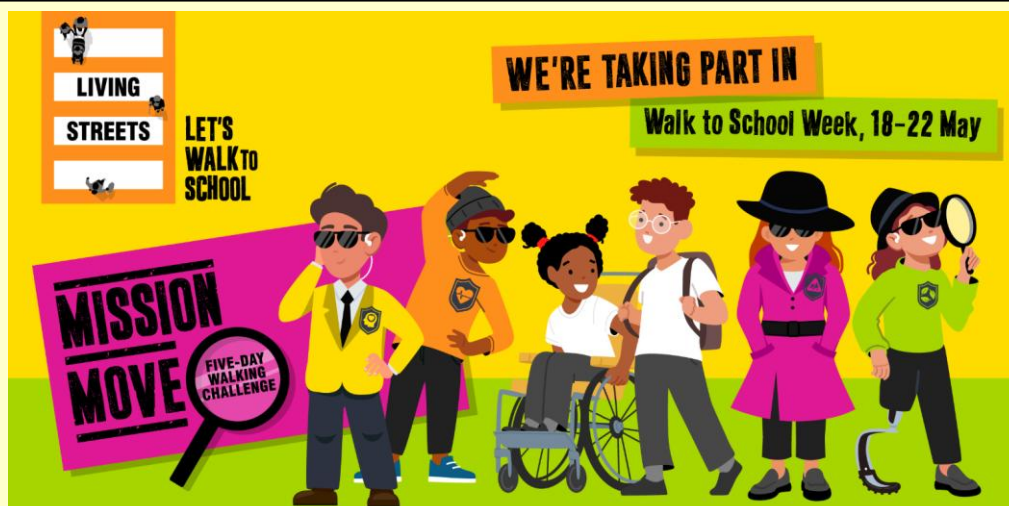

## Snap shots of our learning!

Foundation – In Foundation, the children have made story maps of their text Mr Gumpy's outing and have been thinking about how they have changed since they were babies. In RE they have been considering what is beautiful in the world and how different people have different ideas of beautiful.

Class One – Children have been reading the book Dear Earth and considering how they would use adjectives to describe the features of the planet and consider what kind of adventure they would like to have in far-off places. In PE, they took part in a mini-Olympics with Mr Overton and their points contributed to their allocated country!

Class Two – Have completed their letters to the Solar Farm, and in art have been working in pairs to complete some shadow sculptures which they will display next week they have used. In maths they have been learning about money and budgeting and how it is similar to using decimals.

Class Three – The children have been free sculpting using clay to make an item of their choice and have watched as yeast respired and produced carbon dioxide gas which inflated balloons!
