The children loved their workshop last year and we can't wait to see what delights they bring us this year! Books will be available to purchase on the day



Snap shots of our learning!

Foundation – In Foundation, the children have been writing sentences to describe minibeasts and have been investigating different habitats that they live in. They have used their observations to create detailed pictures of them and they look fabulous!

Class One – Children have been researching microhabitats within the school grounds and have been on a mini-beast hunt. They have designed and made their own bug hotel to encourage more wildlife into the school garden and have made lift-the-flap books about their discoveries.

Class Two – Children have explored structures by creating models from cocktail sticks and marshmallows and have also been experimenting using coding to produce an LED name badge using micro:bits! They have started to write non-chronological reports about the bees we find in our locality.

Class Three – The children have begun a non-chronological report about a mountain of the children's choice and will be writing a persuasive leaflet to encourage people to visit it. They have learned about ancient civilisations and studied sources from The Shang Dynasty, Ancient Sumer and the Ancient Egyptians. In science they have been learning about inherited characteristics.
