Snap shots of our learning!

Foundation – In Foundation, children have been using their Design and Technology skills to make 3D-caterpillars in preparation for them receiving delivery of their own real-life ones that they are going to hatch into butterflies. They have been investigating capacity during water play and comparing odd and even numbers by seeing whether they can be split into equal groups – what a busy week!

Class One – Children have used the book “You Must Bring a Hat” as inspiration for a picnic-themed week of lessons. They have learned about different food groups in Science and carried out research in Maths using tally charts to determine what kind of sandwiches they needed to make to suit preferences.

Class Two – Children have begun designing their pavilions in D and T and have been considering the lifecycle of humans in PSHE. They have also been working hard to master converting 12-time to the 24-hour clock.

Class Three – The children have been considering how the River Nile was important to the Ancient Egyptians and how certain animals have adapted to harsh habitats such as deserts. In English, they embraced the upcoming World Cup by engaging in a live write-along about football!

PENALTY NOTICE FINES FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IS CHANGING



1

FIRST OFFENCE

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or irregular Attendance the amount will be:

£160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days
Reduced to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

SECOND OFFENCE (WITHIN 3 YEARS)

The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance the amount will be:

£160 per parent, per child to be paid within 28 days. No reduced rate will be offered.

The following changes will come into force for Penalty Notice Fines issued after **19th August 2024**.

THIRD OFFENCE AND ANY FURTHER OFFENCES (WITHIN 3 YEARS)

The third time an offence is committed for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance a Penalty Notice will not be issued, and the case will be presented straight to the Magistrates' Court. Magistrates' fines can be up to £2500 per parent, per child.

Cases found guilty in Magistrates' Court can show on a Parents future DBS certificate, due to failure to safeguard a child's education'.

10 SESSIONS (5 DAYS) OF UNAUTHORISED ABSENCE IN A 10-WEEK PERIOD

Penalty Notice Fines will be considered when there has been 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10-week period.
