What We Will Learn!

Maths

Both year groups will study Place Value and Addition and Subtraction in discrete year group sessions.

English (Reading and Writing)

We will be sharing the book 'When the Mountains Roared' by Jess Butterworth and using it as inspiration for setting descriptions, diary entries and persuasive leaflets. We will also use the short animation 'Rock, Paper, Scissors' to create character descriptions.

Science

We will be investigating the animal kingdom, finding out what animals eat, and what the functions of the skeleton and teeth are. We will also investigate food chains and webs and use our school grounds for inspiration!

RE

Children will consider what the idea of life being a journey may look like to a Christian.

History

We will be using our historical skills to discover what it was like to live in Stone Age Britain and compare life then and now using a range of sources. We will use the book 'Secret of the Stones' to capture what it might have been like to be a Stone Age child!

Art

Children will use mixed media to create paintings using inspiration from their work around the Stone Age and pre-historic paintings!

Music

Inspire Music will be providing the children with instruction to play Tocca Drums!

PSHE

Children will explore what it means to be in the world in a digital age.

PE

Children will engage in a range of games teaching ball skills and will develop their understanding of what it means to be a team. PE days are Tuesdays and Thursdays and full kit will need to be worn to school.

Computing

Emails and communication will be explored and children will learn the difference between software and hardware so they have an understanding of how they work together.

French

Children will learn who the different people in their family are and how to describe them using simple vocabulary.
