Climate School 180 (CS180) is Learning through Landscapes' climate-focused initiative which aims to develop and share a better understanding of how schools can implement quality climate change education in their setting.

Working in partnership with the [University of Stirling](#) and funded by the [Alan and Gill Gray Foundation](#), Climate School 180 supports primary and secondary schools across the UK to identify the impacts of climate change on their school grounds and implement nature-based solutions.
