Additionally, having worked as a Teaching Assistant at Beckingham Primary School for the last 3.5 years, Mrs. Markham has made the decision to step down from her 1-day a week role to further progress her career in the beauty industry. Nevertheless, from September, Mrs. Day has been successfully appointed into a new, full-time, 5-day a week, Class 2 teaching role at Beckingham.
